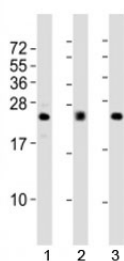

## Description

Plays an important role in the regulation of cell survival, cell division, angiogenesis, cell differentiation and cell migration. Functions as potent mitogen in vitro.

## Application Notes

Titration of the FGF2 antibody may be required due to differences in protocols and secondary/substrate sensitivity.

## **Immunogen**

This FGF2 antibody was produced from a rabbit immunized with a recombinant protein.

## **Storage**

Aliquot the FGF2 antibody and store frozen at -20oC or colder. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
