<b>Formulation</b>	Liquid in PBS containing 50% glycerol, 0.5% BSA and 0.02% sodium azide.
<b>Storage</b>	Store at -20°C . Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
<b>Protein Name</b>	High affinity cAMP-specific 3',5'-cyclic phosphodiesterase 7A (EC 3.1.4.17) (HCP1) (TM22)

<b>Cellular localization</b>	[Isoform PDE7A1]: Cytoplasm, cytosol . PDE7A1 (57 kDa) is located mostly to soluble cellular fractions. . ; [Isoform PDE7A2]: Cytoplasm . PDE7A2 (50 kDa) is located to particulate cellular fractions. .
<b>Purification</b>	The antibody was affinity-purified from rabbit antiserum by affinity-chromatography using epitope-specific immunogen.

<b>Background</b>	The protein encoded by this gene belongs to the cyclic nucleotide phosphodiesterase (PDE) family, and PDE7 subfamily. This PDE hydrolyzes the second messenger, cAMP, which is a regulator and mediator of a number of cellular responses to extracellular





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signals. Thus, by regulating the cellular concentration of cAMP, this protein plays a key role in many important physiological processes. Alternatively spliced transcript variants encoding different isoforms have been described for this gene. [provided by RefSeq, Jul 2011],



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
